## [Important] Notice on the Change of University of Toyama graduation ceremony

Notification on February 26, 2020 Update March 4, 2020

The graduation ceremony at University of Toyama, which was scheduled to be held at the Toyama City General Gymnasium on March 24 (Tuesday), was canceled due to concerns about the spread of new coronavirus infections.

The graduation awarding (granting) ceremony for each undergraduate school or graduate school will be held as of the day.

Graduates, parents and their families have been looking forward to this ceremony. We are very sorry if we understand your feelings, but we decided to give top priority to preventing the spread of infection in Japan and overseas and to ensure your safety. We hope that you will understand.

The response may change depending on the status of the spread of infection in the future, so please continue to check the University website.

## [For parents and families of graduates]

• The award ceremony for each undergraduate or graduate school will be held only by graduates. Parents and their families will not be able to participate. Please refrain from coming.

## [For graduates]

- On the day of the undergraduate and graduate school graduation awarding (granting) ceremony, please disinfect your hands with alcohol and wear a mask at the entrance of the venue. In addition, take care to protect your health condition by washing your hands, disinfecting your hands with alcohol, and preventing infection by cough etiquette such as masks.
- If you fall into any of the following categories, please refrain from attending to prevent infection to other participants.
- ① Returners from mainland China (including Hong Kong and Macau), Korea, Iran and Italy have not passed two weeks from the date of return, as of the day of the diploma award ceremony (March 24) for each faculty and graduate school.
- ② Those who have cold symptoms such as fever in themselves and their family members

  [For current students]
- From a public health perspective, current students (other than graduates) should be avoid coming. In addition, it is prohibited for current students to see graduates off near the venue or to toss them into the air.
